

PURCHASER and SELLER agree that should the stallion die or be sold by its owners or, for whatever reason becomes unfit for service, this contract shall be null and void.

Live Cover

If live cover, PURCHASER is responsible for **boarding fees (\$15 a day)** and any other charges occurred by said mare (vet bills, hoof trimmings, etc) while at Grateful Pine Farm.

PURCHASER agrees that the mare shall be healthy, free from disease or infection and in sound breeding condition. Any mare accepted for live cover must be current on all vaccinations and provide proof of such from the mares veterinarian. No mare will be accepted for live cover who is still nursing a foal.

It is agreed that neither SELLER nor PURCHASER shall be liable or responsible to either party for any disease, accident, injury or death to the mare or stallion.

While the mare is boarded at Grateful Pine Farm, SELLER will do its best to ensure safety of mare. PURCHASER will be notified of any situation in which it may be necessary to call upon a veterinarian. In the event of an emergency, or if the PURCHASER cannot be reached, PURCHASER authorizes SELLER to obtain treatment of the mare by a licensed veterinarian, and agrees to pay all costs associated with such treatment.

Artificial Insemination (AI)

If breeding is done by Artificial Insemination (AI), PURCHASER is responsible for his or her mare's care, housing, and any other charges occurred by said mare (vet bills, etc) off site from Grateful Pine Farm.

The mare to be inseminated must be registered and have DNA typing on file with the NFHR. A DNA typing kit is available through the NFHR and uses a hair sample from the tail. Contact Jeanne Poirier, the NFHR Registrar, at 303-684-6466 or jeanne@nfhr.com for more information.

Semen is only available fresh cooled. Frozen semen is not available at this time.

A collection fee of \$460.00 per collection is due to SELLER prior to collection. Collection will occur at Pilchuck Equine Hospital and is only available Mondays, Wednesdays, and

Fridays. Rico will be actively competing and clinicing during breeding season. PURCHASER shall coordinate with SELLER one month prior to planned breeding to check show schedule.

PURCHASER must use a veterinarian for cycle tracking and insemination. Reproductive specialist is preferred. PURCHASER must provide veterinarian's contact information below. PURCHASER or mare's vet should contact SELLER when mare is ready to have semen shipped. If stallion is home, he can collect next day (on Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays) if SELLER is notified by 7pm the previous day.

PURCHASER is required to rent an Equitainer to transport semen. Equitainer rental is included in the collection fee. Equitainer must be returned to Pilchuck Equine Hospital or Grateful Pine Farm within 10 days of insemination. PURCHASER is responsible for cost of shipping via FedEx expedited shipping.

PURCHASER will ensure that the original RECEIPT FOR TRANSPORTED SEMEN is signed by veterinarian or mare owner at time of insemination and returned to the SELLER within 10 days. Both the RECEIPT FOR TRANSPORTED SEMEN and the CERTIFICATE OF STALLION SERVICE will be included with the shipment of semen or mailed separately to the mare owner.

The CERTIFICATE OF STALLION SERVICE must have the date of insemination filled in by the mare owner or vet and will be retained by PURCHASER for registration of the foal.

Please review the NFHR document ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION PROCEDURES (enclosed) prior to signing this contract.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Severability. The invalidity of any provision of this Agreement, as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall in no way affect the validity of any other provision hereof.

Waivers. No waiver by SELLER of any provision hereof shall be deemed a waiver of any other provision or of any subsequent breach by PURCHASER of the same or any other provision.

Choice of Law. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Washington. Any

legal action commenced to enforce or interpret this Agreement shall be brought in state or federal courts with the appropriate jurisdiction, located in Snohomish County (County) Washington (State). The parties hereto consent to both venue and jurisdiction.

Attorney's Fees. If either party named herein brings an action to enforce the terms of this Agreement or to declare rights hereunder, the prevailing party in any such action shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs to be paid by the losing party as fixed by the court or arbitrator.

Entire Agreement. All preliminary and contemporaneous agreements and understandings are merged and incorporated into this Agreement which contains the entire agreement between the parties. This Agreement may not be modified or amended in any manner except by an instrument in writing executed by the parties.

ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION PROCEDURES

The NFHR recognizes and approves the use of Artificial Insemination (AI) using live or frozen semen provided the following criteria are met:

1. The Stallion whose semen will be transported for AI breeding must have DNA typing on file with the NFHR Registrar before resulting foals will be registerable.
2. The Stallion whose semen will be transported for AI breeding must have a completed Application for Transported Semen Permit on file with the NFHR Registrar prior to the transport of semen.
3. The Mare to receive AI service must have DNA typing on file with the NFHR Registrar before resulting foals will be registerable.
4. Each shipment of semen is to be accompanied by a completed NFHR Receipt for Transported Semen.
5. The NFHR Receipt for Transported Semen is to be completed and signed by the person performing the AI procedure. The original is to be returned promptly to the Stallion Owner/Agent and the copy retained by the Mare Owner.
6. The Stallion Owner/Agent is to retain the original of the completed NFHR Receipt for Transported Semen for inspection by the NFHR if so requested.
7. The NFHR Certificate of Stallion Service to be completed by the Stallion Owner/Agent is to note that the service was by AI and record the dates on which the insemination occurred, as indicated by the person performing the insemination on the returned NFHR Receipt for Transported Semen.
8. When completing the annual NFHR Stallion Breeding Report, the Stallion Owner/Agent is to indicate those mares receiving AI service and record the dates on which the insemination occurred, as indicated by the person performing the insemination on the returned NFHR Receipt for Transported Semen.
9. The resulting foal must be DNA typed before it is registerable and the registration paperwork must include a completed NFHR Certificate of Stallion Service.
